# ACADEMY 1, ACADEMY 1B, ACADEMY 2, ACADEMY 2B

- Dance Bag (a closable bag that will fit all dance shoes/items)
- Label ALL dance shoes & dance clothing with dancers name as best as you can



### **GIRLS BALLET**

- PINK ballet shoes
- Pink footed tights (NO nude tights)
- LIGHT PINK or BLACK color dance leotard (no gymnastics or ice skating leotard as they are cut differently)
- ALL hair pulled back into secure bun
- Optional:
  - Black or Pink Ballet specific pull-on skirt (no ties as they tend to cause distraction. No tulle or frills/tutus)
  - LIGHT PINK or BLACK dance sweater (no coats or sweatshirts)

#### GIRLS TAP

- Nude /Tan Tap Shoes
- PINK footed tights (nude tights are ONLY FOR PERFORMING)
- Same attire as Ballet
- ALL hair pulled back into bun/pony; extra rubber bands for hair in bag
- Optional:
  - Solid black color Jazz shorts/leggings
  - RMSA black tshirt/ plain black tshirt
  - Black or light pink dance sweater (no coats/sweatshirts even if cold)

## GIRLS JAZZ/HH (DUAL DISCIPLINE CLASS)

- Nude Jazz Shoes
- Non-Marking, no light up tennis shoes (not used anywhere but for dance class)
- Solid BLACK dance leotard (no gymnastics leotard as they are cut differently)
  - OR solid BLACK tshirt or RMSA tshirt
- Pink or Black footed tights OR solid black leggings w/black socks
- Hair pulled back into secure bun or pony and out of eyes
- Optional:
  - Solid BLACK Jazz shorts worn over tights
  - BLACK Dance sweater (no coats or sweatshirts even if it's cold)

#### **BOYS ATTIRE**

- Ballet-Plain white t-shirt
- Jazz/HH and Tap- plain white or black RMSA tshirt
- Black sweatpants/shorts/tights (boy tights are different than girl tights; they are thicker and not see through)

### **BOYS SHOES**

- Ballet: Black ballet shoes (black socks)
- Tap: Flat Black Tap shoes with laces (black socks)
- Jazz: Black Jazz Shoes (black socks)
- **Hip Hop:** Non-Marking, no light up tennis Shoes (not used anywhere but for dance class)

Hip Hoppers- PLEASE MAKE SURE DANCER CAN
